

BARC 2 Meter Radio Net Preamble

QST, QST, QST, This is (*Your call sign*) _____ My name is _____ . I will be your net control for tonight's net. At this time, I have been authorized by the **Batesville Area Radio Club** to use this frequency for our weekly radio net. We would like to thank the CAUHF group for the use of the link. We meet each and every Monday night at 2000 hours – 8:00 Central Standard Time, for several reasons: To test our equipment, practice our skills and to learn and practice how to correctly check into a net. We welcome all properly licensed amateur operator's regardless of location or club affiliation to check into the net. **Remember, this is a directed net and stations should transmit only when directed by Net Control.**

When you call into the net, give my call sign: (*Your Callsign* _____) please do not un-key, give your call sign, followed by your name and location. Please give your call sign slowly and phonetically. Remember when you check in please make it a single transmission.

If emergency traffic should arise during the net, use the words BREAK, BREAK followed by your call sign, you will then be recognized and authorized to give your emergency information.

At this time I will take any emergency or priority traffic, please call (*Your CALLSIGN*) _____.

IF THERE IS TRAFFIC- ASSIST THEM WITH THEIR EMERGENCY AS THE SITUATION CALLS FOR: THEIR EMERGENCY SHOULD TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER ANYTHING ELSE WE NEED TO DO.

IF NONE:

Are there any stations that have any special announcements for the net? Please call (*Your CALLSIGN*) _____.

IF THERE ARE THEN YOU WOULD SAY TO EACH OF THEM ONE AFTER THE OTHER:

(*Their CALLSIGN*) _____, This is (*Your CALLSIGN*) _____ Please give us your announcement now.

IF THERE ARE NONE OR NO MORE THEN YOU WOULD SAY:

Are there any stations who need to come in short time, just in and out, call _____ and I will get you on the list.

AFTER SHORT TIME CHECK-INS - START REGULAR CHECK-INS

At this time we will begin our regular check-ins, all licensed amateur radio operators are welcome to check into the net.

Please call (Your CALLSIGN)

(Make a list of Callsign, name and location on separate sheet of paper.)

READ THE LIST OF STATIONS THAT CHECK IN: YOU MAY STOP AND GO OVER THE LIST AS OFTEN AS YOU NEED TO IN ORDER TO GET IT RIGHT. YOU MAY FOLLOW THESE STEPS IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

(Read the list as you have it)

Are there any corrections? Call (Your CALLSIGN).

Are there anymore check-ins ? Call (Your CALLSIGN).

(repeat above as often as you need until you think you have all the check-in's at this time)

IF THERE ARE NO MORE, PROCEED TO LIST FOR COMMENTS

(Give their Callsign and ask)

Comments for the net tonight? *(or your version of the same)*

(Remember every 10 minutes you will need to ID your station) You might try the following.

This is (Your CALLSIGN) with the BARC Monday night net.

(Then call your next station on the list for comments.)

AFTER ALL HAVE HAD A CHANCE TO COMMENT, ASK:

Are there any more check in's ? Call (Your CALLSIGN).

IF THERE ARE THEN ADD THEM TO LIST AND THEN ASK FOR COMMENTS.

IF THERE ARE NO MORE CHECK-IN'S OR COMMENTS THEN CLOSE THE NET:

If there are no more check-ins I would like to thank each of you for checking in and for your patience. At this time *(current time)* _____, I will close the

Batesville Area Radio Club net, and return the frequency to normal operation.
